

Mental Health First Aid (MHFA) Instructor Training

PUBLIC INSTRUCTOR CERTIFICATION PROCESS

The prerequisite to the Instructor Training is taking a [MHFA Course](#) in the curriculum that you plan to teach. MHFA certificates expire after three (3) years, so if you do not have a valid MHFA certificate, you will need to retake the course.

To [become an Instructor](#), candidates complete an application (10-15 minutes), self-paced pre-work (approximately 2 hours), a remote 3-day Instructor-Led Training, and self-paced post work (1 hour).
